# Tools

Please find below a list of the tools and equipment I have used during the tutorial. Remember these are guides and suggestions only. Don't worry if you haven't got some of the list as I'm sure you will have something in your cupboard that will work instead ... especially when it comes to dusting colours!

## **Modelling Tools**

- Star tool
- Ball tool
- Rolling Pin
- Non stick board
- Scalpel
- Textured veining tool
- Pliers (cutting and shaping wires)

## **Paint brushes**

- Small glue brush
- Dusting brushes with flat head
- Fine brush for painting

# **Cakey Tools**

- Pale Yellow or Cream Thread
- Burgundy Thread
- Nile green florist tape
- Burgundy florist tape
- Dark brown florist tape
- 22g Green or White wire
- 26g Green
- 28g Green and White wire
- 30g Green wire
- Ribbon shredder
- Small scissors
- Pallet mixing dust paints
- NOTE ... In the video I use white wires for petals and green wires for leaves, but white wires can be used for everything!

## **Cutter & Veiners**

Hellebore petal veiner if you have one, however Peony / Lily veiner or similar will do

- Hellebore Double Vision petal cutter I used Rose petal OR Cosmos petal cutters
- Rose leaf veiner small (Tea Rose is nice one Great Impressions) used for Rosehip Leaves
- Multi leaf veiner or simple Honeysuckle leaf veiner (Snowberry Leaves)
- Serrated edge leaf cutters thin or a serrated leaf cutter that can be gently shaped used for Hellebore Leaves
- Great Impressions Hellebore leaf veiner possible substitute Foxglove
- FMM Rose leaf cutters
- Multi-leaf cutters

# **Ingredients**

- Semolina Fine grade
- Edible glue / pva glue (whichever is applicable)
- 100g White flowerpaste or Cold porcelain
- 100g Green flowerpaste or Cold porcelain
- White Acrylic paint if using Cold Porcelain
- Confectioners Varnish
- Hairspray for Cold Porcelain to seal in the colour. Use as you would an edible glaze!

## **Dust Colours**

- Plum (Fractal)
- Peony Rose (Edible art)
- Orchid White (Edible art)
- Primrose (Fractal)
- Egg Plant (Fractal) or Aubergine
- Light, mid & Dark green dust
- Canary yellow (Fractal)
- Racing green (edible art)
- Metallic Silver (edible art)
- Bishops purple (Fractal)
- Navy blue (Fractal)
- Dark and mid brown (Fractal)
- Burgundy (Fractal)
- Cherry Red (Fractal)
- Gooseberry Green colour paste (Sugarflair)
